

Statement of Intent: Catch-Up Premium for Years 7-11

Scope:

Catch-up premium expected of £86,480, less £29,000 Year 7 Catch-Up funding that has been replaced and was already budgeted for = net funding £57,480.

Proposal:

There are three strands to the SRWA Catch-Up Strategy:

1. Intensive maths support through an employed tutor, to deliver one-to-one online tuition;
2. Cross-curricular support through an employed Graduate Academic Tutor, working on-site to deliver one-to-one and small group tuition;
3. Registration on the National Tutoring Programme, for recognised tutors to deliver one-to-one online tuition.

Timing:

Tuition to begin at the start of Oct 2020 and run for 21 full school weeks until Easter.

Delivery:

Students will be selected based on progress data and teacher assessment. The National Tutoring Programme, and employed intensive maths support, will be delivered via online tuition. The cross-curricular support by way of an employed Graduate Academic Tutor will be delivered on-site. All sessions will take place according to SRWA COVID protocols.

Costs:

1. **£34,139**
2. **£15,900**
3. **£ 7,500** (25% subsidy - matched by 75% from government, further £22,500)
